

Ice Show Feature Skater Solo Procedure October 2019

Qualifying Competitions/Events:

- Skate Canada Saskatchewan Sectionals
- Saskatchewan Winter Games
- Canada Winter Games
- Skate Canada Challenge
- Skate Canada Nationals

Feature Skater Solo Numbers:

To a maximum of 12 solos/pairs will be available to balance the ice show.

Skater Eligibility:

- Skate Saskatoon Member
- Member in good standing
- All Champions, and medalists in all Disciplines will be considered for a solo.
- Soloists and Pairs selected must have achieved a minimum of 14.5 points in the long program.
- grade 12 skaters who have competed at the pre novice level and above.
- grade 12 Star skaters will be eligible for either a group number or solo (depending on nos. of eligible skaters)
- all skaters that competed in Junior and Senior level events at Sectionals.
- Saskatchewan Winter Games Champion (every four years)
- Canada Winter Games participant (s) (every four years)

Note:

In the event we have no medalists from Sectionals we will look at the highest point scores until our minimum quota of soloists is met (minimum of 14.5 points in the long program criteria met).

All Decisions are based on making the best show possible with all decisions made with the utmost fairness in mind to all skaters involved.

Base criteria will be posted Nov 1 of each year.

Should modifications to the guidelines be required, Skate Saskatoon board of directors and club members must be informed by December 31 (after Sectionals and Challenge).

Any concerns regarding assignment of featured skaters will be brought in writing and signed to the Ice Show Directors (Contracted coaches) whom will in turn notify the board in writing.
